#### Part-II

Q.No.2.Atenant'A', purchased the colony land in an open auction in 1944. 'A' died in year 1945 after paying the first installment of sale price where after his two sons—'B' and 'C'—paid the remaining installments of the sale price and sale mutation was sanctioned in their favour in 1956. A daughter'D' of the deceased tenant — subsequently challenged the mutation by claiming 'Shari' share in the property. Please explain; (Marks 5+5+5+5)

- (i) Whether tenancy devolved upon the daughter ('D')on death of her father ('A')?
- (ii) Whether the father had become owner of the property, and the daughter is entitled for her 'Shari' share?
- (iii) Whether section 19-A of the Colonization of Government Lands (Punjab) Act, 1912 will apply?
- (iv) Whether the daughter does have the 'Shari' share in the property?

Q.No.3. 'A' belongs to Jat community which is 30% of the population of the entire village 'K' and he was appointed as first Lambardar/headman of the village/revenue estate by the authority. 'B', a land owner in the village belonging to Gujar caste which constitutes 70% of the total population of the village challenges the appointment of 'A' as Lambardaron the ground that he belongs to the majority Gujar caste and, thus, had the preferential right to become a Lambardar. Please explain:-(Marks 8+7+5)

- (i) Whether 'B' being member of majority caste in the community has got preferential right to be appointed as a first Lambardar/headman?
- (ii) What will be your decision on question of appointment of 'A' as Lambardar?
- (iii)Which provision of the law governs the proposition?

Q.No.4. A lot measuring 120-Kanals of colony land, situated in District 'B' was allotted/leased to 'A' for a period of twenty year in 1964. On 27.04.1985 the colonization officer resumed the land on account of failure of 'A' to meet the conditions of the allotment and simultaneously request of 'A' for purchase of the allotted land was turned down on the ground, inter alia, that the application was time barred. The Colonization Officer, after due notice to 'A' and hearing him, passed the order of resumption. 'A' challenged the order of resumption before the Civil Court through a civil suit which was decreed. Please explain; (Marks 10+10)
